TICI definitions

2a = <50% of Target territory: e.g., one full M-2 or partial M-2's

2b = more than half the affected territory is open but less than 90%

3a (2c) = greater than 90% of all branches/capillaries are open but not a normal angiogram

3b (3) = complete antegrade reperfusion of all vessels in the target territory
